Dear Parishioners

It is with great to be back at the Cathedral (HTC) this morning hoping to re-establish my connection as on the first Sunday of each month. I have always tried to connect to the King Valley and will now include Wangaratta West & The Warbys (WWW). In addition to all of this, my ministry extends to 25 Pastoral Charges which includes 65 Churches all over our Diocese.

I had hoped to conduct all Sunday services at Holy Trinity Cathedral during August, but this will no longer be possible. We look forward to the ministry of Canon Bill Squire on 18 August and Canon Matthew Healy on 25 August. I will preside next week, but we intend to have a 'service with a difference' with our Music Director and Choristers taking the lead during worship.

I remain very grateful to the Canons of the Cathedral and many other clergy who have assisted with all divine services as I could but only coordinate the ministry. I am also very grateful to Dr Crichton for his organization of all the administrative and practical ministry matters as well as all those who have responded as volunteers to different ministries. I look forward to the Induction and Installation of the new Vicar and Dean which will enable me to focus on my widespread Diocesan role and responsibility. I know that you will be in the same good hands as our fellow Anglicans at WWW.

I was hoping to make recommendations today following a discussion regarding service times and frequency for the new cooperative ministry but as I was unable to facilitate that, I have agreed with Archdeacon Neil that we will retain the present structure of service times and frequency until end of November with a very slight alteration. Future proposals will be handled by the new Dean and respective Parish Councils and Congregations. Be aware that in maintaining the structure this will incur extra costs. I hope to appoint an Assistant Priest (part time) to assist with services, understanding that we have a cohort of clergy living in Wangaratta who can also assist.

Thank you to the 62 congregation members from WWW and HTC who have responded to our invitation to join us for lunch today. Unfortunately, we cannot accommodate last minute requests. **Please use the side entrance (second gate) or front entrance.** In trying to ensure that we do mix with each other, seating has been arranged accordingly.
