Today, December 15th is the Twenty-Eighth Anniversary of Ordination to the Priesthood for our Bishop. Congratulations Bishop Clarence on this anniversary and may God continue to bless your ministry.

This coming week we have the "run-down" to Christmas Day beginning in earnest, with the start of the "O" antiphons.

The first one being *O Sapientia*.

17 December marks the start of the week before the celebration of Christmas, the birth of Christ, and at evensong, the great Song of Mary, the Magnificat, has a refrain or antiphon attached to it proclaiming the ascriptions or 'names' given to God through the Old Testament. Each name develops into a prophecy of the forthcoming and eagerly-anticipated Messiah, Jesus, The Son of God.

- 17 December—O Sapientia, or O Wisdom,
- 18 December—O Adonai,
- 19 December—O Root of Jesse,
- 20 December—O Key of David,
- 21 December—O Dayspring,
- 22 December—O King of the Nations,
- 23 December—0 Emmanuel.

These antiphons are the basis for the hymn O come, O come Emmanuel, which as can be seen from the above list actually starts with the last antiphon and uses only 5 of the 7 antiphons.
