At the recent meeting of Parish Council the idea of inserting a half-pane of glass in the top section of the (usually) non opening doors on both sides of St Michael's Hall was discussed. This would serve 2 purposes,

- 1) if anyone is outside and needs to see if people are inside and maybe the door is locked they can attract attention and gain admittance.
- 2) from a 'Safe Church' perspective it minimises the risk that a person can be in an unsafe situation if outsiders can see in.
